Cherry Pecan Bread

Prep: 10 min. Difficulty: Easy
Cook: 50-60 min. Serves: 6-8 people

Ingredients

- 1 Cup of Sugar
- ½ Cup of Salted Butter
- 2 Eggs
- 2 Cups of All Purpose Flour
- 1 tsp of Baking Soda
- 1 Tbsp of Baking Powder
- 1 Cup of Buttermilk
- 1 Cup of Chopped Pecans
- 1 (10oz) Jar of Maraschino Cherries (Drained and Chopped)
- 1 tsp of Vanilla
- 1 tsp of Salt

Preparation

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
2. Cream sugar and butter in a large bowl.
3. Add eggs and mix.
4. Stir in flour, baking soda, baking powder, and salt.
5. Stir in buttermilk, vanilla, cherries, and pecans.
6. Pour batter into a greased loaf pan.
7. Bake at 350 degrees for 50-60 minutes.
8. Cool in pan for 10 minutes then remove and cool.
