Instructions. They are very helpful when we follow them. When I was in school I would often find myself daydreaming as the teacher would be talking then suddenly it was time to do an assignment and I had no clue what to do because I didn't listen to their instructions. This usually led to me getting a less than desirable grade on my assignment. Of course there was no one to blame but myself and I would have to suffer the consequences of failure that on one occasion resulted in my missing out on my summer off to attend summer school. I never however had a teacher that refused to tell me the instructions and what to do and when I would ask for their help in trying to understand they were always glad to help. Sometimes our relationship with God is similar to the situation I just explained. God most certainly wants us to follow His instruction. In doing so we follow Jesus and are less likely to find ourselves in unpleasant consequences. The Bible is God's very word given to us so we can learn and grow in Him. Sometimes though we don't take the time to read it and as a result we are more prone to failure. God doesn't leave us here on earth to figure out everything for ourselves, He instructs us through His word, but it is our responsibility to read it! When we do the Holy Spirit is able to work in us in whatever we may be going through. At times God's word may be tough because it convicts of sins in our heart that we need to deal with but this is a good thing and we should be glad we have the Bible to convict us in those ways. God's word is always pointing us to Jesus and away from sin. If you haven't read it lately you should. I think you'll be glad you did.
