WORD

No one should deceive himself. If anyone among you thinks he is wise in this age, he must become foolish so that he can become wise.

1 Corinthians 3:18

It may be time for you to start living a little more foolishly. That is probably not the advice you were expecting to read in the newsletter this month, nor is it the type of advice preachers often give, but as counterintuitive as it may seem, there is a time when being viewed as a fool is a good thing. There are many in the world who think it foolish to believe in an all powerful God and a Savior who died on a cross for the forgiveness of our sins. Most who hold such a view would consider themselves to be wise, Paul on the other hand says otherwise. If believing the gospel truth of Jesus Christ crucified and resurrected is viewed as foolishness, then Paul says we all need to become a little more foolish. If one becomes too wise in their own eyes, it is likely they will fail to see the need for God. This type of thinking may have the deceptive appearance of wisdom in this life, but will leave those who possess such worldly wisdom looking foolish in the life to come. I don't know about you, but I would rather follow Jesus and play the part of the fool in this life and be able to see God's perfect wisdom for eternity, then pretend to be wise in this life only to live in my foolishness for eternity. Wisdom that arises from humility is a beautiful thing and it is also necessary to enter into the kingdom of God. It is when we humble ourselves that we discover true wisdom. Worldly wisdom is nothing more than our pride in disguise. When we lay down our pride and realize that we must be fully dependent on God, it changes our life and saves our soul. This change comes when we humble ourself before the cross of Jesus. It is there that we discover perfect wisdom. I hope you have discovered that wisdom today.
