IN THE WORD

So we do not focus on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

2 Corinthians 4:18 (HCSB)

Seeing is believing. That is the thought of many people in the world today. God however calls us to believe in things that are unseen. The Bible calls this faith (Hebrews 11:1). Biblical faith draws our focus to something better than we can see. In this world we see much evil and many hard times. If this world is all there is, then there is not much for us to get excited about. In these verses however, Paul reminds us not to focus just on what we see, because what we see is only going to last for a little while. Paul is able to make it through the difficult times in his life because his focus is not on where he is now but on eternity. Paul is not worried about a present defeat because he knows he has eternal victory in Jesus. It is easy for us to get stressed over tough situations we may be going through because our problems seem bigger than we can handle and they very well may be. While our problems may be bigger than us, Jesus is bigger than our problems. Our faith in what we don't see must be bigger than our fear of what we do see. Focusing on your present struggles will burden you. Focusing on Jesus will give you rest. Have you put your faith in Jesus? Are you trusting Him? He will give you strength to get through your temporary struggles and the hope to look forward to an eternity freed from them.
